

HK Teacher Candidates

An applicant becomes a Teacher-Candidate by submitting to HK a formal application and paying the application fee. This application fee is not refundable but will be applied to the Teacher Registration Fee upon final approval to teach, unless the candidate takes more than 18 months after the application date to complete the approval process. It is suggested that a person waits to submit the formal application until more than half the requirements have been completed. This application is required before the candidate can be evaluated for *Energy Readiness to Teach HK*. Candidates are required to be Certified HK Practitioners.

A Teacher-Candidate pays one-half the fee for the first repeat of any class (just as anyone else).

Teacher Authorization is initially for two years. Additional performance and renewal requirements may be added later.

After a Teacher qualifies to teach a particular class, the Teacher may attend that same class, taught by any other teacher, for free. Any class the Teacher attends which is new to the Teacher is paid for the same rate that any other student pays. There may be some fees due to the host teacher, to cover new manuals, refreshments, or so on.

Newly Authorized Teachers must teach their first class within the first 9 months, at least 3 classes every two years, with a minimum total of 26 students, in order to remain classified as Active Teachers.

To re-activate their status as Active Teachers within the first year after not meeting the minimum requirements, a Teacher must attend / repeat the class, or co-teach a class with a currently active teacher (whose experience is at least four classes and two years). In the future there will be a requirement for all teachers to attend a Teachers Update Class every several years. Requirements have not yet been set for re-activation of teacher's status after a lapse of over one year, but there likely will be requirements beyond those listed above.

Teachers must submit class rosters to HK within 30 days after the class ends, Teaching Royalties will be paid to HK per student in class. This royalty fee goes to maintaining records, providing attendance certificates, etc. Later, HK will, for a nominal fee, provide mailing lists for all students / prospective students in the teacher's area. Teachers do not have any specific territory, and may teach classes anywhere. Teachers, do, however, communicate and co-ordinate with each other.

Teachers should submit to HK their class schedule a minimum of 60 days ahead of time, preferably 120 days. This is necessary in order to include the class on our HK-Training.org

website. Copies of all advertising materials must be submitted for approval. Later, HK will provide teachers with model copy for advertising HK and HK classes.

Currently, HK will provide a copy of our most recent teaching materials to be photocopied and used in the class. When class manuals have been published, Teachers must download the current up to date manual for their classes. Supplementary hand-out materials provided by teachers to their classes should be submitted to HK. Other teachers may also find them useful.

HK will refer all class or client inquiries to the nearest teacher(s).

All these items are provisional and subject to addition and change.
